### **ROLE DESCRIPTION & SPECIFICATION**

### **Role: Treasurer (Voluntary Trustee position)**

#### Overview:

- 1. To maintain an overview of VAR's financial affairs, and ensure that they meet all necessary legal requirements;
- 2. To ensure that appropriate records are kept and that there are effective financial procedures in place;
- 3. To monitor and report on the financial health of the organisation;
- 4. To participate actively in risk management processes; and
- 5. To oversee the production of necessary financial reports/returns, accounts and audits.

## **General responsibilities:**

- 1. To liaise regularly with the Chief Executive, relevant staff and Trustees to ensure the financial viability of the organisation;
- 2. Ensure that the Trustees are aware of their financial obligations and to take a lead in interpreting financial data;
- 3. To ensure that there are regular financial reports available for Board meetings;
- 4. To contribute to the collegiate decision making of the Board;
- 5. To participate in regular risk management processes;
- 6. To contribute towards a strategic, forward looking, financial summary in accordance with VAR's Business Plan:
- 7. To oversee the production of an annual budget, in consultation with the Chief Executive & Finance Officer;
- 8. To ensure that proper records are kept and that effective financial procedures are in place:
- 9. To appraise the financial viability of plans and proposals:
- 10. To lead on appointing and liaising with auditors and/or an independent examiner; and
- 11. To lead the Finance Sub Group (FSG) meetings.

## **Treasurer Person Specification:**

- 1. Commitment to the aims, objectives and values of VAR:
- 2. Willingness to give the time and effort required to fulfil the role;
- 3. Knowledge and experience of current and fundraising finance practice relevant to voluntary and community organisations;
- 4. Knowledge of bookkeeping and financial management, as required;
- 5. Sound financial analysis skills; and
- 6. Ability to communicate clearly.
